

## Place de la Concorde's redevelopment

The aim of this lighting project is to give back to this public space a nocturnal functionality, while restoring and enhancing its former architectural shape, composition and uses. According to Jacques Hittorff's 1830s plan, light poles are re-installed, respecting the horizontals, verticals and radials alignments coming from the emblematic fountains. Typical Champs-Élysées' columns are raised, in line their historical installation. The project plan to reuse widely this heritage, ensuring that the lighting complies with the requirements and gives back
