



a walk by the sea on Agadir's Corniche

(Agadir, Morocco)

The lighting project for the Corniche d'Agadir revitalises the seafront while adopting a virtuous and responsible approach to the environment. The new lighting reuses and renovates rather than breaks and replaces. Much of the existing infrastructure has been reused and embellished: the poles, which generally account for more than 40% of a project's carbon footprint, have been restored. The existing networks have been retained and improved. The stadium floodlights have been replaced with colourful, controllable LED solutions that are cleaner for the night

sky and much more energy efficient. The lighting design creates a colourful carpet of light along the Corniche promenade and on the beach. Throughout the route, projections of patterns inspired by local culture punctuate the walk, to the delight of children and selfie enthusiasts.
