



Lighting Master Plan of Rennes Metropole

(Rennes, France)

In 2012, the city of Rennes adopted an innovative Lighting Development Master Plan (SDAL), designed by the Concepto agency, which notably implemented a 'black grid' principle. The city's departments and elected representatives wanted to provide the city with a similar tool: a SCAL Lighting Development Coherence Scheme. The future result of a concerted approach between the metropolitan elected representatives, it will aim to

make the public lighting and illumination actions of the municipalities more consistent. Its main and structuring orientations are: the biodiversity conservation, the reduction of energy consumption, the rationalisation of maintenance, and the creation of a global community image enhancing both the action of each individual and the community links that make up the territory.
