

A royal square in the heart of the city (Orléans, France)

The illumination of the historical facades bordering this main central and emblematic square of Orléans city, composes a luminous frame to the project of the square itself recently delivered by Coup d'Eclat. The façades and their rotundas that mark the streets, are subtly lighted by LED luminaries in warm tones. The whole square is unified by a line of light in the higher part of the contemporary façades. The lighting

is modulated to achieve various lighting ambiances for the square.
