



Renovation of the Château de Montbéliard

(Montbéliard, France)

This majestic site invites visitors on an immersive journey through its exhibition spaces, where light and history blend harmoniously. In the reception area, warm lighting and chandeliers highlight the architecture of the site. The first three sequences immerse the audience in the evolution of the region, from its geological origins to contemporary artists' workshops. Each space features a unique lighting ambiance: golden display cases and projections reveal hidden fossils and minerals, while dioramas showcase

animals in dynamic, changing settings. The use of sustainable LED lighting, combined with a centralized management system, ensures environmentally friendly illumination designed to preserve the exhibits while enhancing visitor comfort. The transformation of the esplanade emphasizes the scenic viewpoints of the castle. From this rocky platform, soft lighting provides optimal orientation toward each zone.
