The operation provides for the construction of shared facilities (mosque, sports centre, learning centre, restaurant), administrative offices and shops, bordered on both sides by student residences. The shared facilities are grouped around a large multi-functional square which is a major living and gathering place. Based on the concept of «biophilic urban planning», which places man at the heart

of urban biodiversity, the design enhances the landscaped and green spaces. The lighting project stages the central esplanade according to events and seasons, while the surrounding buildings are underlined by light (Halle, university restaurant, mosque, etc). The campus' lighting atmosphere is simple with, here and there, squares with a specific lighting identity.
