



new exchange and services hub (Annemasse, France)

The multimodal exchange hub, just delivered and designed by Gautier+Conquet office, is a new meeting place, a crossroads for flows, and a new space for services and activities. The lighting of the forecourt, its seats and all the elements of the landscape emphasise this new dynamic, while an atmosphere of half-light creeps in between. The sloping roof and the interior volumes of the station building are illuminated to help define a new image for the district

and a real sign in the urban landscape. Under the station, the underpass linking the northern district to the southern square is designed for both its daylight qualities and its night-time atmosphere. The northern square is also illuminated. It is located on the site of the demolished former railway rotunda, and is one of the structuring places of this new eco-district. © Gilles Bertrand
