



The Thermes l'Oréal in Saint-Gervais-les-Bains

(Saint Gervais France)

Renovation of the existing building of the Thermes de Saint Gervais Les Bains built in the early 1990s. The starting point for the landscape project and the interior design of the thermal baths building is «Water in all its states». The metaphor of water is declined between the gaseous and liquid state to give a layout comprising three large landscape entities: a mist garden at the back of the building, a condensation garden (the Gontard well),

a drop and the wave it diffuses to the existing wooded park in front of the main façade of the building. As close as possible to this concept, the lighting sublimates these arrangements at night : lighting of the outside spaces, illumination of the facade, lighting of the outside thermal path. All our proposition is designed in white, golden and soft shades of light, enhancing the luxury of the proposed experience.
