



Requalification of the MAMAC

(Nice, France)

The Museum of Modern and Contemporary Art of the city of Nice is at the heart of the programme for the rehabilitation of the Promenade du Paillon II in Nice. The lighting project for this building enhances the interior light. The glazed spaces diffuse a white - neutral - light towards the outside, the interior of the building radiates onto the heart of the MAMAC. At the beginning of the night, if the museum is closed, low-power standby lighting allows

the interior of the building to continue to exist - while respecting the amount of light tolerated by the works. In addition, a very soft veil of light materializes the façade. © Carrhilo da Graça
