



Revitalise the shopping experience

(Lyon, France)

The Part-Dieu shopping center is getting a new look with the rehabilitation, transformation and extension proposed by MVRDV and SUD architects. The signature motif of the original building is repeated on the new matriculated concrete panels that cover all the facades. It is deconstructed and evaporates at the entrances, which are marked by huge glass walls. The Lantern, on the west side, offers a new access to the city center. At night, the

massive effect of the building is highlighted by a silver light, while the interior volumes radiate a golden glow. We ensure the lighting of the facades, the exterior spaces, and the signage, in close interface with the interior lighting.
