



Sports and cultural facility - a beating heart lighting up

(Chambéry, France)

Interior and exterior lighting design for the Chambéry Métropole sports and cultural complex. The project includes two halls, one with 6,000 seats and the other with 2,000 seats. The red concrete veil in the centre of the glass structure is lit like a beating red heart. To highlight this red, the surroundings are bathed in icy hues.

The forecourt is treated as a calling area, with specially designed masts and colour effects that change according to the seasons and the cultural programme.
